| Sept. 24-30 | Doubles facts (2+2, 3+3, etc.) | Rainbow write: write each double in a different color pen or marker | Type all of the doubles facts on a computer | Find doubles in your home/yard (pair of shoes, piles of sticks, etc.) | Write out the doubles facts, cut them up, and match them like a puzzle | Practice the doubles, combinations of 10, +1s, and +0s in a comfy place |

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
